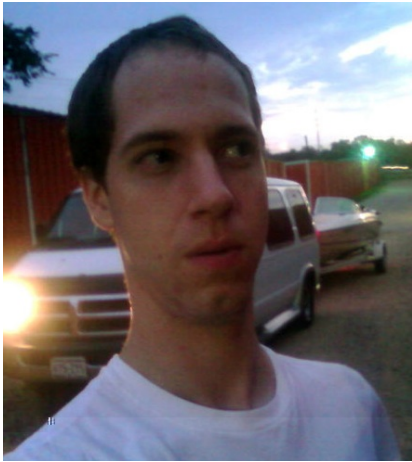


## Is it finally time to embrace cfscript?
